

Parental authorization form

The country to which you are traveling requires that minors (anyone under the age of 18) present a Parental Authorization Form at the airport or when checking into hotels indicating that the participant has permission to travel with the group.

This form must be completed and notarized in the presence of a notary public within 30 days of departure. You must take this form with you on tour. Do not send it to EPXCURSIONS.

- If parents of a minor are married, **both parents must sign the form**, even if one parent is accompanying the minor.
- If parents of a minor are divorced, **both parents or the legal-custody parent must sign the form**, and proof of divorce must be established on the form during notarization. Proof of divorce and a court order showing sole custody must also be taken with you on tour, as it may be required at the airport.
- In the case of a deceased parent, a death certificate is required during notarization. A copy of the death certificate must also be taken with you on tour, as it may be required at the airport.
